SELF-RESET OF PRIMEMOBI LOGIN PIN (M-PIN), TRANSACTION PIN (T-PIN) AND DEVICE

We have introduced a new feature on PrimeMobi that will enable Users to Self-Reset Login PIN (M-PIN) and Transaction PIN (T-PIN).

Users can also Self-Reset the device for PrimeMobi if accessing PrimeMobi from a new device.

Users of PrimeMobi App will no longer need to fill out PIN/Device Reset Application form to have their PINs/Device reset. All these can now be done easily and securely from the PrimeMobi App.

The following new features will be available to PrimeMobi Users:

Users will be required to setup two Security Answers to use the Reset feature. PrimeMobi App will prompt the user to setup the Security Answers during login.

Users can modify the Answers through "Manage Security Questions" option provided under "Privacy Settings" in PrimeMobi

On the PrimeMobilogin page, the user needs to tap on the **"Reset PIN"** link.

- > Answer two secret questions

RESET TRANSACTION PIN (T-PIN)



On the PrimeMobi login page, the user needs to tap on the "Reset PIN" link



User will be prompted to enter the following:

- > PrimeMobi User ID >
 - Mobile Number registered for PrimeMobi
- > Answer two secret questions



The user will then receive a six-digit One-Time PIN (OTP) via SMS which they need to enter.





On successful validation of OTP. User will be prompted to set their new PIN.
